As an extra incentive rewards up to \$2,500 are paid for information which leads to the arrest and indictment of a person (s) that committed a homicide. 
In our 27 years of serving the Greater Baton Rouge Area, Crime Stoppers has assisted law enforcement in solving 10,274 felony crimes and has paid \$1,365,600 in cash rewards all anonymously. That's approximately 1.04 felony crimes solved each and every day for the past 27 years at a cost of \$133 per felony crime solved.

Quite cost effective!

During 2009, several new initiatives were implemented that had an impact on the community: "Deadbeat Parents", a program working with the District Attorney's Office that targets parents who are delinquent in paying child support, "Digital Billboards," Crime Stoppers working in conjunction with LAMAR Advertising featuring the most violent of criminals by utilizing digital billboards, "Cold Case/Cold Deck" playing cards a collaborated effort with the State Department of Correction in which a deck of playing cards features 52 unsolved homicides, missing person and unidentified remains cases across Louisiana. Some 10,000 decks of cards have now been placed at every State Prison facility available to the inmates, and finally "Increase Cash Rewards up to \$2,500" for information leading to the arrest and indictment of an individual (s) for homicide. All of these initiatives have one common goal, to make our community a safer place for everyone.
